The Broadcast Engineering Technology Specialization Scholarship

The Broadcast Engineering Technology Specialization Scholarship is for the Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology Degree Program at Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC). The scholarship seeks to reward academic excellence and encourage students to pursue technical education. As a student, the applicant must have completed at least 8 credit hours at GPTC, and be registered for 8 credit hours or more for the "FALL" semester at GPTC. The scholarship is awarded as a one-time \$1000 credit to the student's account. Please check with the Registrar to be sure you are counting all applicable credit hours. Do not count credit hours for courses not specific to your Program of Study listed on your transcript.

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must submit a completed and signed Scholarship Application.
- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicants must present a written recommendation from an instructor, with original signature.
- Applicant must be registered as a current, full-time student in good standing pursuing a Broadcast Engineering Technology Specialization within the Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology degree program at Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC).
- Applicant must have completed at least 8 credit hours at GPTC, and be registered for 8 credit hours or more for the "Summer" semester at GPTC.
- Applicants must show proof of registration for the next semester (8 credit hours or more).
- Applicant must submit a one-page essay describing their need for this scholarship and a description of their education and career goals.
- Applicant must have successfully completed the ECET1101 and Circuit Analysis I and BCET 2121 Video and Audio Systems Course with a grade of "B" or better.
- Applicants must submit an "unofficial" copy of transcript.
- Applicants must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and demonstrate financial need (to be verified by Financial Aid office).
