**The INDUSTRIAL MAINTENANCE** program is an intensive 12-14 week program that prepares individuals for success in the rewarding field of advanced manufacturing.

The program is geared toward **unemployed and underemployed individuals who have little or no manufacturing experience, but who wish to re-enter the workforce with new and in-demand skills.** Participants are introduced to the fundamental concepts and skills required by industrial maintenance technicians in manufacturing. Industrial maintenance technicians combine knowledge of mechanical technology with knowledge of electrical and electronic circuits. The program fee and all required materials are covered for those who meet eligibility requirements
