## PAUL M. STARNES SCHOLARSHIP

The Paul M. Starnes Scholarship is awarded to first year students who have completed at least 12 credit hours. (Transfer credits not included). This scholarship is awarded up to \$500 credit to the student's account at the GPTC Bookstore.

## **IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!**

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Applicants must submit a completed and signed Scholarship Application.
- □ Applicants must have a cumulative 2.5 minimum grade point average or higher.
- □ Applicants must present a written recommendation from an instructor, with original signature.
- □ Applicants must be pursuing a degree or diploma program of study.
- □ Applicants must have completed a minimum of 12 credit hours at GPTC, must be registered for 12 credit hours for the next semester, and provide proof of registration.
- Applicants must present a statement of purpose and career goals typed and signed.
- Applicants must include proof of current participation in a student organization or community/volunteer service. Must have <u>original</u> <u>signature</u> by a leader in the organization that can verify involvement.
- □ Applicants must submit an "unofficial" copy of transcript.
- Applicants must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and demonstrate financial need (to be verified by Financial Aid office).
- ☐ If awarded, recipient must attend the Scholarship Luncheon held in May.
- ☐ If awarded, recipient must send acknowledgement letter to scholarship provider
