STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The Rotary Club of Stone Mountain Scholarship (RCSM) Fund, established in Fall 2008, will assist with tuition and fees for a full-time student pursuing a degree or diploma program at Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC) Clarkston Campus.

Selection Criteria

Student has demonstrated the potential to complete their selected program of study (POS) at GPTC and will apply their education to assist in the growth and well-being of their community in accordance with the goals of Rotary International and the RCSM.

Cumulative GPA, and extracurricular activities (on or off-campus)

Scholarship Guidelines

In order to qualify for a RCSM scholarship, a student must have completed at least ($\frac{1}{2}$) half of the credit hours required of their program of study, exclusive of developmental studies/learning support courses. The criteria for awarding the scholarship are:

- Attend RCSM meeting once per quarter.
- Attend RCSM sponsored social functions as possible.
- Make a presentation to RCSM, as requested.
- Maintain full time student status (12 credit hours or more).
- RCSM scholarship recipient must maintain the same field of study noted on scholarship application
- Cumulative 2.5 minimum G.P.A. and Work Ethics grade of a 2.0 or better.
- Maintain conduct consistent with the standards of RCSM and Rotary International.
 - (To be provided by RCSM)
- Be a member of GPTC Rotary Club (once established).

Please note: By adhering to guidelines as outline above, this scholarship is available for possible renewal. The RCSM Scholarship will not exceed four (4) semesters.

Scholarship Guidelines

Each application must include the following:

- Applicant must be a full time student pursuing a degree or diploma Program of Study (POS) from Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC) Clarkston Campus.
- Applicant must provide a GPTC transcript.
- Applicant must meet the cumulative 2.5 minimum G.P.A and Work Ethics grade of a 2.0 or better.
- Applicant must submit a one (1) page typed letter detailing why he/she is applying for the RCSM scholarship. Please discuss career goals, academic expectations and extracurricular on & off-campus activities.

General Information

- Applicant must have completed (1/2) half of the credit hours required of their program of study, exclusive of developmental studies/learning support courses.
- Membership in Rotary is encouraged, once the club is established.
- All applications and materials must be submitted to the Georgia Piedmont Technical College **Foundation Office** by designated deadline.
- The selection process will be handled by the Georgia Piedmont Technical College **Foundation** Scholarship Committee and RCSM. The RCSM Scholarship is awarded once per semester.

Scholarship Application Deadlines and Notification

Priority will be given to those students applying before or on the required deadline. Applications received after this date will only be considered if funds are still available. Scholarship recipients will receive an award letter by the first week of the Fall Semester.

Application deadline is August 16th annually, unless otherwise posted.
