

RETENTION RATES

The respective Full-Time and Part-Time Student Fall Cohorts represent those students who, in the prior fall semester, attended GPTC as a first-time College student (i.e. had not previously been enrolled in any other college) during either that specific fall semester or during the summer semester immediately prior. The respective retention rate reflects the percentage the Full-time or Part-time cohort students from the previous year (less those who were legitimately excluded) who enrolled at the college as either full-time or part-time students in the current year.

GRADUATION RATES, Disaggregated

The graduation rates presented here is calculated as the total number of completers from the First-time, Full-time Fall cohort who completed their program within 150% of the normal time for completion divided by the number in the revised cohort less any allowable exclusions.

Note: Due to cohort sizes of less than ten individuals, data for the following race/ethnicity groups have been suppressed: American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian, Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander, Hispanic, Two or more races, Race/Ethnicity unknown, Nonresident Alien.

JOB PLACEMENT RATES

The data below reflect the total unduplicated number of graduates in that academic year and their latest placement record for the fiscal year. The Overall Placement Rate is based on the unduplicated number of graduates and unduplicated employment status. The Placed in Field rate excludes from the calculation those students who did not enter employment in field or in a related field, students chose to continue their education, and students who were unavailable for employment.
