



FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES

Tuition is \$3434. The program is eligible for Zell Miller grant, HOPE grant, PELL, and the GI Bill

Zell Miller Grant –

- Must be Georgia resident for previous twelve (12) months
- Cannot have Bachelor degree or higher (Associate's ok)
- Must maintain 3.5 GPA per semester (around 92 test grade avg.)

This grant will reimburse the tuition 100% after the semester if the GPA is maintained

HOPE grant –

- Will pay approximately \$1005 toward tuition leaving a remaining balance of approximately \$2352
- Must be Georgia resident for previous twelve (12) months
- Cannot have a degree (Associate's, Bachelor's, or higher)

PELL grant –

- Eligibility dependent upon income (there's not a specific \$ amount, dependent upon various factors)
- If eligible, our experience has been that it pays approximately \$1900 (leaving a balance of approximately \$452, after HOPE and Pell).
- Sometimes it will pay more depending on the students need

GI Bill –

- Military Benefits
- Experience has been that not only does this pay tuition, other monies are also paid to student such as monthly stipend and living expenses
