



Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

This Transfer Admissions Guarantee will serve as an agreement between Atlanta Metropolitan State College (hereinafter referred to as AMSC) and Georgia Piedmont Technical College (hereinafter referred to as GPTC).

Purpose:

The overall purpose of the AMSC and GPTC TAG is to provide a BRIDGE program for GPTC students to transfer to the AMSC Criminal Justice, Bachelor's Program. AMSC and GPTC believe that through this TAG agreement, students will transfer and attain a high quality B.S. degree, while reducing time to completion.

Section A. GPTC Student Eligibility for the TAG

1. Students awarded the Associates in Applied Science Degree in Criminal Justice from GPTC.
2. Students with the following designations:
 - a. Jointly Enrolled Students - allows students to take courses at both institutions towards the B.S. Degree (Program Maps/Pathways will be provided to students); and
 - b. Transfer Students – requires 30 or more earned credits (Program Maps/Pathway will be provided to students)

Eligible student participants will be required to complete the AMSC Bridge Program based on the approved Guided Pathway. The Complete College Georgia Articulation Agreement's approved list of courses may be used to satisfy the AMSC Bridge requirement where appropriate prior to the awarding of the B.S. in Criminal Justice Degree.

AMSC Bridge Program consists of the following courses:

- (1) AMIR 1001
- (2) *Two, 3 Credit Hour Science Courses,
- (3) Two, 1 Credit Hour Science Lab Courses,
- (4) POLS 1011,
- (5) HIST 2111 or HIST 2112,
- (6) ENGL 1102,
- (7) **Two Social Science Electives.

3. Students without the Associates in Applied Science Degree from GPTC must satisfy requirements of the AMSC ***Freshman Index

* Science and Laboratories courses taken at AMSC must be selected from Area D - Science, Math, and Technology. Science and Laboratories courses at GPTC must be selected from Area III – Natural Sciences.

** Social Science electives taken at AMSC must be selected from Area E – Social Sciences. Social Science electives taken at GPTC must be selected from Area II – Social/Behavioral Science.

***Freshman Index: 2.0 GPA and 430/400 SAT and 17/17 ACT.

Section B. Transfer and Substitution of Courses (See Attached Guided Pathway)

1. AMSC will accept the following course transfers and substitutions from GPTC students enrolled in the Criminal Justice, Bachelor’s Program:

Section C. General Agreement

1. Tuition/ fees rate will apply based on the prevailing rates at the respective institutions.
2. Both parties agree to put forth a good faith effort for program success.
3. Both parties agree that the terms of this agreement shall serve as a TAG reviewed and signed annually from the date of this agreement.
4. Both Parties agree to conduct regular recruiting activities and evaluate the TAG jointly at least once annually to determine the best options for success.
5. This TAG may be terminated by either party by a decision determined to be based upon mutual consent, or if, after entering into this agreement, either party is unable to provide one or more of the services outlined herein. A written termination letter must be received 60 days prior to the termination date. This letter should be delivered to the proper authority representing this agreement.
