

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT  
 SAINT LEO UNIVERSITY  
 AND  
 GEORGIA PIEDMONT TECHNICAL COLLEGE

**I. SCOPE AND PURPOSE**

- A. *Articulated programs:*** Saint Leo University (SLU) and Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC) hereby enter into the following articulation agreement governing the matriculation of selected GPTC Associate of Applied Science degree programs and SLU Baccalaureate of Arts and Baccalaureate of Science degree programs.
- B. *Purpose:*** It is the intention of this articulation agreement to facilitate a seamless transition from the GPTC Associate in Applied Science to Baccalaureate programs at SLU.
- C. *Understanding of the parties:*** For all GPTC Associate in Applied Science graduates admitted to SLU during the term of this agreement, SLU will:
  - 1. Accept the Associate of Science students as having junior standing, with the understanding that students may need to complete certain general education courses and prerequisite courses for the program in which they enroll.
  - 2. Accept maximum hours transferred (64 semester hours); require students to enroll in a minimum of 15 semester hours in the major with SLU and a minimum of 30 semester hours with SLU. Students are required to earn a minimum of 120 semester hours to graduate. In addition, a minimum of 39 hours of coursework must be completed at the 300-400 level for the bachelor degrees.

*Severability:* If, for any reason, any provision of this agreement is held invalid, all other provisions of this agreement shall remain in effect. If this agreement in whole is held invalid or cannot be enforced, then to the fullest extent permitted by law, any prior agreement between the parties shall be deemed reinstated as if this agreement had not been executed.

### **III. BUSINESS AGREEMENT**

#### **Article 1- Termination**

This agreement may be terminated by either party upon at least sixty (60) days written notice given by either party.

#### **Article 2- Term**

This agreement shall continue in effect for five (5) years from the date signed, unless terminated by either party in writing of their desire to have it terminated. The agreement and understanding



that termination will not be executed without a negotiated teach-out agreement for students currently enrolled.

### Article 3- Acceptance by Parties

The parties are committed to the concept of a long-standing agreement. This agreement will be amended when Articles are added, deleted or significantly modified. Amendments must be in writing and may take the form of letters signed by the signatories or their designees. The agreement may be reviewed at any time at the request of either party.
