INDUSTRY RECOGNIZED CREDENTIALS

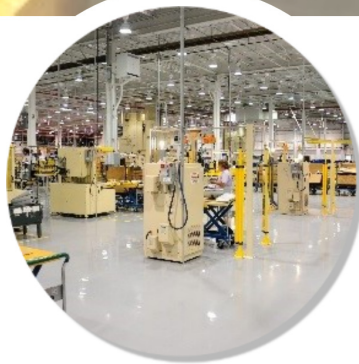
