

## Dependent Verification Worksheet

Your 2019-2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for a process called verification. Before awarding Financial Aid, we are required to confirm the accuracy of the information you reported on your FAFSA. To verify that you provided correct information, we will compare your FAFSA with the documentation you submit in your packet. Your verification documents will not be reviewed until all requested items are received and you are accepted into a Financial Aid eligible program. Below is a list of verification documents (some may not apply to you). Please check your Student Banner Account at <a href="https://www.gptc.edu">www.gptc.edu</a> to determine which requested documents are needed.

#### A. Dependent Student's Household Information

#### Your Household Should Include:

- Yourself
- Your parent(s), step-parents, or unmarried legal parents who live together (even if you don't live with them)
- Your parents' children or dependents, if they will receive more than half of their support from July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020 and they are required to provide parent information on the FAFSA

### The Number in College Should Include:

- Yourself
- Your parent's other children, if they would be required to provide parent information on the FAFSA

#### The Number in College Should Not Include:

- Your parents
- Your parent's other children or dependents if they are NOT required to provide parental information on the FAFSA

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#### **B. Student Income Information**

**TIP:** The best way to ensure that your FAFSA has accurate tax information is by using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) on your application at FAFSA.ed.gov. In most cases, no further documentation is needed to verify 2017 tax return information if the IRS DRT was used and the information is unchanged.
