About Us

Established in 1961, Georgia Piedmont Technical College (GPTC) – formerly DeKalb Technical College – is one of the largest technical colleges in the State of Georgia. Georgia Piedmont Technical College serves over 25,000 students annually by providing accredited programs, continuing education, and adult education. Our service area includes locations in DeKalb, Newton, and Rockdale counties.

We provide educational training for entry into over 100 skilled and professional occupations. These programs, with enrollment terms ranging from one to eight semesters in length, lead to a Certificate, Diploma, or an Associate in Applied Science Degree.

All programs include classroom instruction (with some courses available online) and practical experience to provide the skills for acquiring and retaining jobs.

Admissions

Georgia Piedmont Technical College's open admission policy encourages students of various educational backgrounds to apply to one of the more than 100 programs of study. The student body is diverse and includes high school graduates (or equivalent), transfer, transient, audit, international students, and F1 / M1 visa holders. In addition, Dual Enrollment and Career Pathways are available for qualified high school 9th-12th graders. Applying students are required to submit:

- 1. A completed application form to the Admissions Office.
- 2. A \$25.00 non-refundable application fee.
- 3. An official high school transcript or GED scores. The application must request that official transcripts be mailed directly to the Admissions Office. If the transcript is in a language other than English, an official international evaluation is also required.
- 4. Satisfactory scores on the Accuplacer Next Generation, SAT, or ACT Test.

Financial Aid

Eligible students can receive one or more types of financial aid while attending Georgia Piedmont Technical College.
