For children and spouses of veterans whose death or disability is service-connected

#### **Chapter 1606**

Montgomery GI Bill (Selected Reserve/National Guard) For members of Selected Reserve or Ready Reserve

#### **Chapter 1607**

For Veteran reserves who were called or ordered to active duty in response to a war or national emergency for at least 90 days after September 11, 2001.
