



- Wear your mask indoors for 14 days
- Social distance when possible
- Wash hands often

- Monitor symptoms for 14 days
- You are NOT required to quarantine as long as you are NOT an inpatient or resident in a healthcare congregate setting
- Quarantine at home for 14 days except in case of emergency or to get tested.
- You may leave quarantine after 7 days IF
  - You do NOT live in a congregate setting
  - It has been at least 7 days since exposure
  - You remain symptom-free
  - You are diagnostically tested no more than 48 hours before end of quarantine but not before day 5
  - You receive a negative result
- If you are unable to get tested, you may discontinue quarantine after 10 days IF no symptoms have emerged
