Transcripts

You must submit a copy of your **Official High School or GED transcript** if you would like to be eligible to receive FAFSA (Financial Aid) benefits. (SAT and/or ACT scores are also sent here if using these scores.) These transcripts can be emailed to transcripts@gptc.edu or they can be mailed to GPTC, Attn: Admissions, 495 North Indian Creek Drive, Clarkston, GA 30021

Official college transcripts are required for GPTC review if you would like to attempt to receive official credit for any college classes taken from another institution prior to attending GPTC. Transcripts can be emailed from those colleges to transcripts@gptc.edu or they can be mailed to GPTC, Attn: Admissions, 495 North Indian Creek Drive, Clarkston, GA 30021

(If Driver’s License /ID is from out of state, please still include this.)
